## **Nursing Community**

**Farewell to Callie Fowler:** Callie, OCN's beloved Communications & Community Education Manager, marked her last day with OCN as she prepares to graduate nursing school and begin a new position at PeaceHealth. **RN Well-Being Project:** The <u>RNWB website</u> has been redesigned and launched. The new website focuses on raising awareness about manageable stressors in healthcare and includes a blog post highlighting this topic.

#### **Public Health & Awareness**

**Mental Health Awareness Month & Nurses Week:** May is Mental Health Awareness Month and National Nurses Week starts next week. An article in the most recent <u>OCN newsletter</u> highlights manageable stressors, or those stressful events inherent in healthcare that cannot be removed.

**Volcano Awareness Week:** Gov. Tina Kotek proclaimed May 18-25 as Volcano Awareness Week in Oregon. Huddlers shared personal stories from the 1980 Mt. St. Helens eruption. There is a <u>virtual storytelling event</u> on May 7 for anyone to tell their Mt. St. Helens eruption story, or just listen in.

### **Clinical Placement & Education**

Concerns About Paid Clinical Placements: There are concerns about out-of-state nursing schools offering payment for clinical placements, potentially crowding out Oregon programs. One employer said they receive payments for physician clinical placements, but not nurses at this time. This conversation generated discussion around equity, competition, and the sustainability of local education systems.

**OHSU/Legacy Merger:** Attendees discussed the implications of the proposed merger, especially its impact on clinical education access. OHSU has created a <u>webpage</u> with information about the merger. A recent article from the <u>Willamette Week</u> also shares some overall updates.
