Nursing Workforce

Policy, Events & Resources

Samaritan Health Maternity Unit Closures: This past week, community members gathered in response to <u>Samaritan Health's proposal to close maternity units</u> in Lebanon and Lincoln City. Huddlers discussed declining birth volumes in these rural areas and examined potential alternatives—such as midwifery-led care and freestanding birth centers—to preserve local access to maternity services. The Oregon Nurses Association (ONA) is currently <u>circulating a petition</u> advocating to keep the birthing centers open.

Federal Rule Proposal – Home Health & Hospice: The Department of Labor has proposed to <u>remove the federal minimum wage requirement</u>. Huddlers expressed concern of how this would impact the home health and hospice workforce.
