Nurse Workforce

OSBN Update: Director Prusak from OSBN shared various initiatives currently underway at the state board.

- Community Engagement: The board has been meeting in different communities across the state. The September board meeting will be held at Adventist Health in Tillamook.
- Policy Fellowship: OSBN is implementing a fellowship for recent DNP graduates to work with the board.
- Licensure Predetermination: OSBN plans to offer licensure predetermination so prospective students can confirm eligibility before completing a nursing program.
- Nurse Practice Act Revision: Work is beginning to modernize the nurse practice act as required by HB 3044.

Rural Health Transformation Program: The Oregon Health Authority is requesting <u>public comment</u> as it prepares to apply for federal funds to support rural health system transformation, as outlined in H.R. 1. Comments are due by Sept. 5.

Huddlers discussed possible uses for these funds, including:

- Creating a rural health resource center to address barriers to care, such as transportation, food delivery, and affordable home repairs.
- Addressing barriers to practice in rural communities, which limit healthcare facilities' ability to recruit and retain professionals, including nurses.
