Potential Loss of Nursing Pipeline Agencies: Federal budgets are proposing discontinuing funding for state <u>offices of rural health</u> and <u>Area Health Education Centers</u>. Loss of these agencies could impact nursing pipeline programs, rural clinical experiences, or data/technical assistance.
