A gathering of Oregon nursing workforce leaders to offer timely updates and share insights from peers and stakeholders.

Nurse Workforce

COVID-19 Vaccine Guidance: Newly issued federal recommendations approve vaccines for adults 65+ and those 6 months-64 at higher risk. Off-label access remains possible for others. Huddlers debated the scientific rationale, insurance coverage, and potential barriers for marginalized populations.

Medicaid Cuts: Huddlers shared ongoing worries about how organizations will sustain services as Medicaid funding decreases. Discussion centered on long-term care, adult foster homes, and the resulting moral distress for staff as patient access and equity face further strain.

Nursing Trust and Professional Integrity: With misinformation increasing and reports of unlicensed <u>nurse impostors</u>, participants reflected on the profession's long-standing reputation as the most trusted. Huddlers emphasized that trust stems from the intimate and holistic care nurses provide, but warned that systemic distrust could have consequences for practice.

Nurse-Led Solutions Highlighted as Future Models: Huddlers explored how nurses might lead emerging models of care outside traditional systems. Ideas included community-based programs, health education in non-clinical spaces, and building grassroots support networks to meet patient needs.
