Nurse Workforce

Updated Vaccine Guidance: OSBN, OMB, and OBOP released <u>a joint statement</u> to clarify that clinicians should write prescriptions with a diagnosis to provide the COVID-19 vaccine, and that pharmacists may administer under those orders. OSBN Director Rachel Prusak emphasized that providers will not be disciplined for prescribing or administering vaccines according to professional guidelines and past practices. Standing orders for vaccines within systems and other employers any are being encouraged to reduce administrative burden. Refer to OHA's FAQ with more information for the public.

Healthcare Workforce Committee Recruitment: The Oregon Health Policy Board's Healthcare Workforce Committee is <u>actively seeking new members</u>, including nurses, oral health professionals, maternal/pediatric health representatives, and a student member. The group meets every other month with a strong focus on health equity and produces the statewide healthcare workforce needs assessment.

Al in Nursing: Huddlers discussed Oregon's recent legislative debate over Al and the nurse title —Al chatbots can still call themselves "nurse," though not "Registered Nurse". Nationally, the FDA will soon <u>hold a committee</u> to make recommendations on the use of Al digital mental health devices.
