# FRIDAY HUDDLE

A gathering of Oregon nursing workforce leaders to offer timely updates and share insights from peers and stakeholders.

#### **Nurse Workforce**

Job Market and Hiring Practices: Participants discussed a tightening job market, especially for new graduates and travel nurses seeking permanent positions. Many reported sending out dozens of applications without hearing back, raising concerns about transparency and hiring freezes across systems. Huddlers encouraged those entering the nursing profession to look outside of typical settings, and recognize the diversity of the settings where nurses work, while also being mindful of the emotional and mental toll healthcare careers can have.

Wellness and Self-Care: Huddle nurses emphasized that long-term sustainability in nursing requires strong boundaries and self-care. Several shared stories about evolving career paths—from bedside care to education or entrepreneurship—to find renewed purpose and balance. Participants recognized anxiety, depression, and exhaustion across the workforce and the need for peer-led resilience efforts. Christy Cowgill shared plans for 2026 nurse wellness retreats to support nurses' mental health and retention - send her an email if you're interested in getting involved.

#### **Nurse Education**

**Oregon Nursing Education Academy:** OHSU's Joanne Noone and Alanna Lowery outlined progress on the Oregon Nursing Education Academy. The academy's impact includes higher certification pass rates (90% versus 69% nationally) and scholarship awards that doubled master's enrollment. The application deadline for the next cohort is 12/15/2025.
