A gathering of Oregon nursing workforce leaders to offer timely updates and share insights from peers and stakeholders.

#### **Nurse Workforce**

**SNAP Freeze Impacts:** Huddlers discussed the halt to federal SNAP benefits affecting one in six Oregonians starting November 1. Governor Kotek's declaration of a statewide food emergency offers short-term relief, but Huddlers expressed concern about patients forced to choose between food, rent, and medication.

**Social Determinants of Health Screenings:** Huddlers will review how their organizations screen for SDOH needs, such as food insecurity and housing challenges, and share findings next week. OHSU highlighted its automated social work referral process as one model for coordinated response.

**Friday Huddle: Extended Cut:** Join us on Friday, November 14th, for a one-hour <u>RN Well-Being Webinar</u> that translates two years of statewide data into practical tools to reduce nurse stress, improve workplace systems, and advance well-being across Oregon's healthcare workforce.
