A gathering of Oregon nursing workforce leaders to offer timely updates and share insights from peers and stakeholders.

Nurse Workforce

Hospital Closures & Capacity: Vibra Specialty Hospital in Portland will close, laying off about 310 staff, while Ashland Community Hospital will close next spring but redeploy staff within the Asante system. Though closures were not explicitly linked to Medicaid cuts, Huddlers saw them as part of a larger pattern of financial strain and worried about what similar changes could mean for rural critical access hospitals and local access to care.

Rural Access & Reality: Huddlers raised concerns about rural patient access, citing higher ED use, longer stays, homelessness, addiction, and patients avoiding routine care due to fear of ICE. Rural nurses reported shortages at all levels, limited education and advancement options. pay gaps, and shrinking specialty and community supports. They saw opportunities to better connect nurses across rural communities to share resources and strengthen practice.
