NURSE WORKFORCE

Legislative Tracker & 2026 Session Preview: OCN shared an early overview of nursing- and healthcare-related bills recently posted ahead of the legislative session. Approximately [ten bills are currently being tracked](#), including placeholder bills and two nearly identical House and Senate bills related to staffing plans. Huddlers were encouraged to flag additional bills for inclusion as more details emerge.

Hiring, Transferable Skills & Workforce Mobility: Huddlers emphasized the importance of recognizing transferable skills when hiring and interviewing nurses. Leaders shared that experience in customer service and other non-clinical roles builds critical nursing competencies such as prioritization, communication, and adaptability. Nurses were encouraged to fully represent their professional backgrounds rather than viewing career transitions as starting over.

Leadership & Well-Being Culture: Participants reinforced that healthy leaders set healthy culture. Modeling behaviors such as taking mental health days and openly discussing workload pressures was highlighted as an important leadership practice within nursing organizations.

Vaccine Guidance & Public Health Coordination: Participants discussed immunization guidance challenges for Federally Qualified Health Centers (FQHCs), particularly those near state borders. While Oregon follows West Coast Health Alliance recommendations, some FQHCs headquartered in Idaho are following federal guidance for operational simplicity. OHA and local public health partners are working on coordination and clarity.

NURSE EDUCATION

Student Loan & Higher Education Policy Update: Huddlers briefly discussed proposed federal rule changes from the U.S. Department of Education aimed at simplifying student loan repayment and increasing affordability. The update was noted as relevant to nurses and nursing students managing educational debt.
