





## The Number of Qualified Applicants Has Declined Since 2021-2022

LPN PROGRAMS SAW THE STEEPEST DECLINE, WITH QUALIFIED APPLICANTS NEARLY HALVED





## After Pandemic-Era Disruptions, Nursing Graduate Numbers Are Rebounding
